ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF REPORT

Subject: Resolution confirming the existence of a local emergency due to the Oregon Fire in Weaverville, CA.

Date: August 26, 2014

ISSUE: Should the Board adopt a resolution ratifying the Director of Emergency Services' proclamation and confirm the existence of a local emergency in Trinity County due to the Oregon Fire, in Weaverville, CA.

Late Sunday afternoon a fire began on Highway 299 just west of Weaverville. Firefighters are currently working to get this fire under control. The fire moved from the Oregon Mountain area northeast towards the airport/East Weaver area during the night.

Early Monday morning the Director of Emergency Services/Sheriff signed a Local Emergency Proclamation due to the fire. This proclamation, unless ratified and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors, will expire on September 1, 2014.

ALTERNATIVES INCLUDING FINANCIAL IMPLICATION:

- Adopt the resolution and confirm the existence of the local emergency.
- Deny the resolution and allow the local emergency proclamation to expire.

RECOMMENDATION: It is staff's recommendation that the board adopt a resolution ratifying the Director of Emergency Services' proclamation and confirm the existence of a local emergency in Trinity County due to the Oregon Fire, in Weaverville, CA.

LOCAL EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2.40.070 of the County of Trinity empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, and;


WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Trinity does hereby find; that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within said county, caused by fire; which began on the 24th day of August, 2014, and;

That these conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County, and;

That the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Trinity is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local emergency now exists throughout said County, and;

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this County shall be those prescribed by state law, by ordinances, and resolutions of this County; and that this emergency proclamation shall expire in 7 days after issuance unless confirmed and ratified by the governing body of the County of Trinity.
